 - Will need to secure a sponsor for participant prizes.
 - Potential Plan: Have a PAC tent at Hello Huntersville with 1 to 2 Plein Aire artists to help promote the event. Later that month host the actual Plein Aire competition along the Downtown Greenway. Possibly partner with 760 for the judging and awards for the artists.
 - Idea...Community vote on which piece(s) the Town would buy to display in Town Hall.
 - Partner with Arts for All Gallery
 - Hello Huntersville: May 4, 2025
 - Possible event date: May 31, 2025 or June 7, 2025
- Electricities Grant
 - \$5000 matching grant

 - Work with North State Development on adding new artwork – Staff will reach out
 - Tap into Culture Blocks through ASC for more programming: Staff met with ASC staff to look at Huntersville facilities this past spring. Hopefully, more artists/groups will be more aware of our facilities for programming space.
- Review SculptOUR RFP for Fall 2025-2027
 - No changes need to be made at the moment. Please review the RFP and we will discuss at the next meeting.

- NC 250 Grant – we did not receive it. There is another round, Kendall will check with the committee on if we can apply again for the same project.

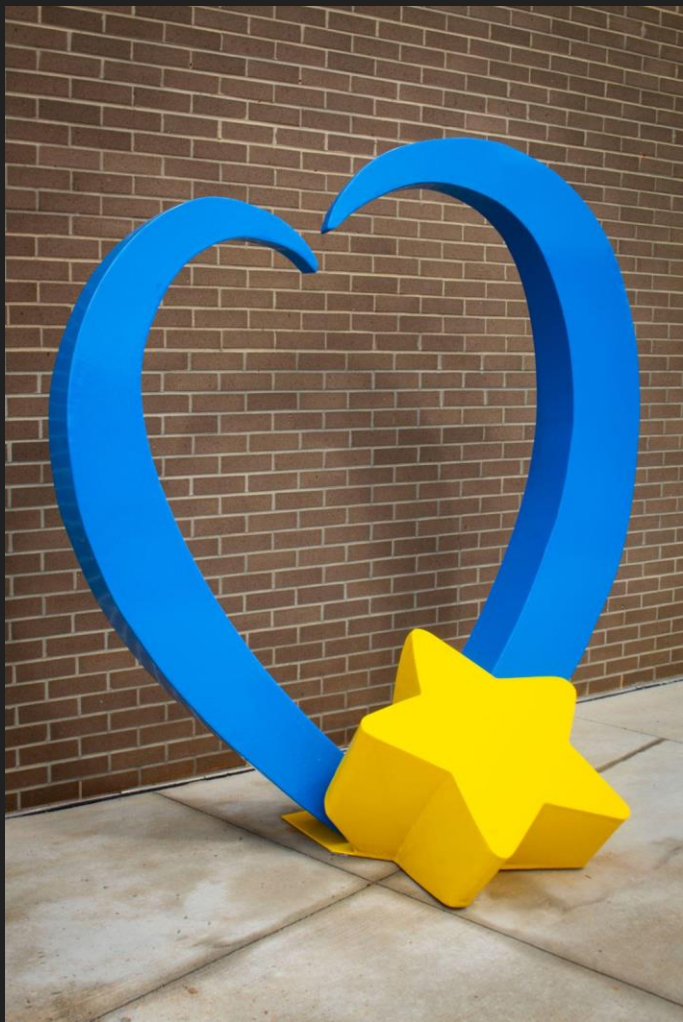

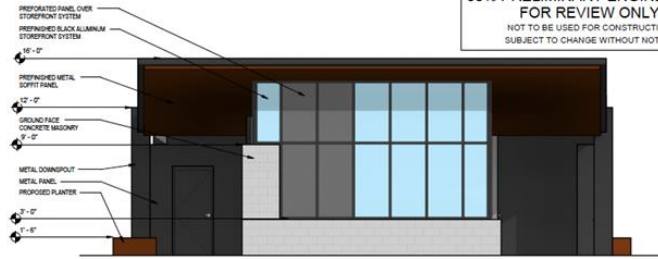

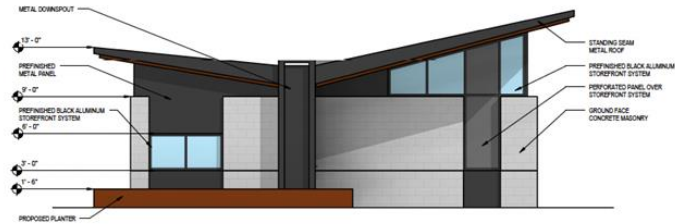

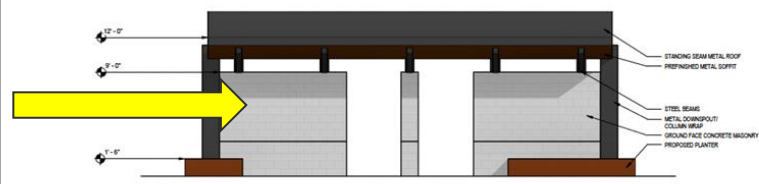

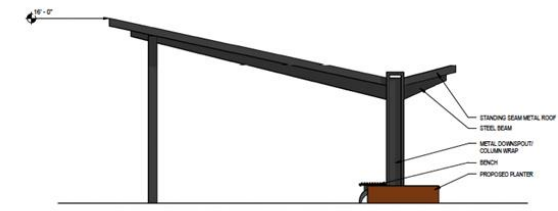
1 EAST ELEVATION - SHELTER 1

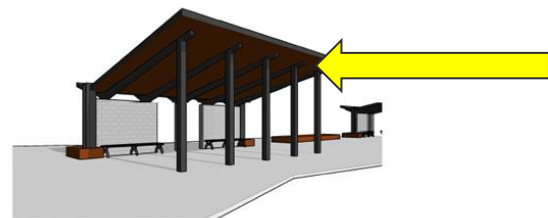
2 SOUTH ELEVATION - SHELTER 1

Huntersville Plein Aire Quick Draw Notes

- 4 hour event, starting at 8:00 am through noon
 - We will give artists an hour to finish and get their entry ready with pieces submitted at 1:00 with judging a
 - The award announcement would be in the afternoon coordinated with the event
 - This would be considered a Quick Draw event
- Artists bring paper or canvas to a central location to have the back stamped
 - Note that only stamped entries will be accepted
 - Artists may prepare paper/canvas but no pre-drawing or painting will be allowed
- Artists may use any medium but work must be completed in the 4 hour window
- Draw from 4 pre-defined locations within Huntersville. These will be advertised, encouraging people to go to the locations to view the painters
 - We will need a Public Art Council member at each location
 - I do not yet have recommendations for sites other than the Greenway
- We will require an entry fee - \$25 to \$30
- 1st Place prize - \$300, 2nd Place - \$200, 3rd Place - \$100 – we may need to get a grant to support the total prize pool of \$600 plus judge's fee
- We will need to find a judge and we will need to pay them \$100 to \$150
 - Robin Stockton will judge or help us find someone to do the judging
 - We will need 23-28 participants to cover the prizes and judges fee
- This will be considered a wet judging event with Artists required to provide framing the day of the event which will be used to hang in gallery
- All pictures submitted for judging must be available for sale
- All pictures submitted will be displayed in the Arts for All Gallery for a specific period of time (to be determined)
 - Robin Stockton has agreed to work with us on the event
 - She charges a commission of 30% on sales
 - We were thinking of a 30 day show but would need to coordinate dates
- Event will need to be advertised as well as appearing on the Huntersville website
 - I would like to see Facebook and Instagram blasts if possible
 - Robin will also advertise on her social media sites
- I recommend that we combine this with Hello Huntersville next May – we may be able to do a standalone event sometime in the future but will want to get established first
