BUSINESS:

- **Raise Grant / YES for Meck**
 - We do not currently have any RAISE or BUILD (RAISE was renamed to BUILD) Grants so we are not at risk of recission.
 - YES for Meck is the campaign to support the county tax referendum to fund infrastructure (40% of revenue will go to roads, 40% to rail transit, and 20% to other transit, such as busses)
- **E-Bike Regulations**
 - Mecklenburg County is working with the surrounding towns to make sure we are all on the same page with rules/best practices
 - Cornelius is currently working on an ordinance for everyone to review.
 - With an ordinance we can enforce/educate e-bike users
 - The town plans to create a promotional video on e-bike best practices while riding around town,
 - GTBC suggested adding etiquette signage along the greenways
- **Consider Adopting the 2 possible alignments for The Seam trail**
 - Through Huntersville, The Seam follows 2 possible routes; one along the future red line and the other running east of the future red line in a few places.
 - There are multiple future developments along this corridor that will affect The Seam route and we make sure to accommodate
